Ages 5-9

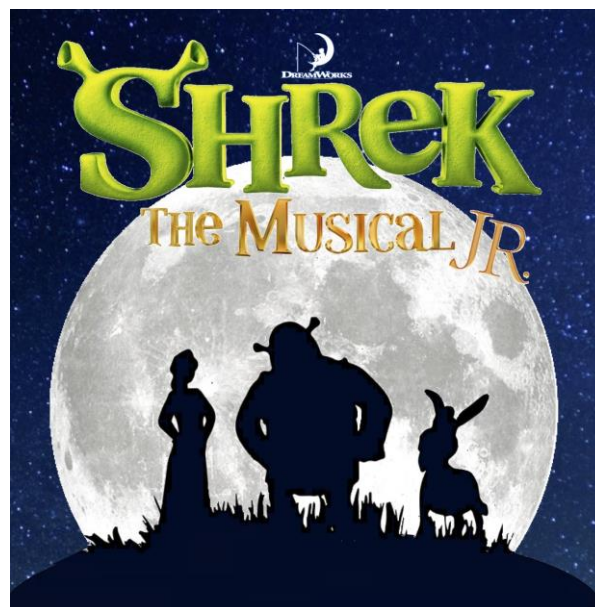
